

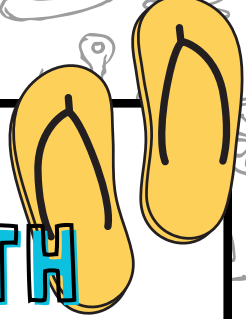
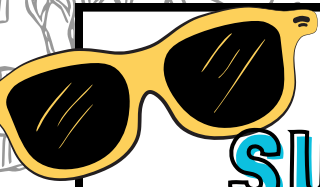


SUMMER READING AND MATH



Below you will find a list of math and reading requirements for students **GOING INTO** 1-8th grades.

1st	Practice addition and subtraction facts to 5, counting to 50, and counting by 5s and 10s to 100.	Students are required to read 15 books to parents, at a rate of 5 books per month. Below a log is provided for tracking and should be returned on the first day of school.
2nd	Addition and subtraction facts 1-10, Counting forward and backward from 1-100, Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s. check out activities on www.fun4thebrain.com	Students are required to read 15 books to parents, at a rate of 5 books per month. Below a log is provided for tracking and should be returned on the first day of school.
3rd	Addition and subtraction facts 1 – 20, skip counting by 2-10. Any practice of addition/subtraction with regrouping is a plus.	Box Car Children Book #1 by Gertude Chandler Werner
4th	Practice addition and subtraction facts from 1-20, multiplication facts up to 12, and 4-digit addition and subtraction with regrouping for a test in the first week of school. 5th	Adding and subtracting 2- and 3-digit numbers, multiplication and division facts up to 12, multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers.	The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C. S. Lewis
